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RE:

The 'Come and See' topics this term are: 'Holidays and Holydays', 'Being Sorry' and 'Neighbours'.

During these topics the children will be:

- Role-playing stories from the Bible
- Writing about stories from the Bible
- Thinking about their feelings
- Exploring how they can help others at home and in school
- Reflecting in a prayerful atmosphere.

'*Journey in Love*'- How we care and help others at home.

Prayers we say in school:

- The 'Hail Mary'
- The 'Our Father'
- Morning prayer (sung):

- Grace (sung):

English:

In our English lessons we will be:

- Exploring the purpose of labels/captions in non-fiction texts and writing our own labels for diagrams
- Writing information texts about the plants and animals we are studying
- Writing poetry based on our study of plants and animals
- Writing postcards and riddles based on Katie Morag and the Isle of Coll
- Letter and instruction writing
- We will be continuing to learn about letters and sounds in our fabulous phonic groups. We will use what we learn in our writing.

Mathematics:

In Maths lessons the children will be learning about:

- Counting and comparing numbers up to 100
- Halves and quarters.
- Word problems involving addition and subtraction, sharing and making equal groups.
- Using mental calculation strategies
- Learning how to tell the time (o'clock and half past)
- 2D and 3D shapes

Science:

Our topics this term are 'Plants and Animals' and 'Weather'. The children will be given the opportunity to investigate:

- Life Processes
- Habitats
- Plants and animals are in our local environment as well as elsewhere in the world
- Names of common trees, plants and animals
- What plants need to stay alive

History:

The children will be given the opportunity to:

- Look at different forms of transport and how they have changed over the years

Geography:

Through our topics the children will be given the opportunity to:

- Locate the Isle of Coll
- Label a map of the fictional island of Struay
- Explore human and physical features of Isle of Coll
- Locate on a map and name the capital cities of Great Britain

Computing:

As well as using computing to support other subjects we will continue our 'Programming' topic. Children will be given the opportunity to:

- Understand sequence of movements by using simple programmes (algorithms)
- Continue e-safety

Art: Through our topics the children will be given the opportunity to:

- Paint
- Use different media
- Make observational drawings
- Sketch
- Learn about the life and works of Arcimboldo

Design and Technology (DT):

Through our topics the children will be given the opportunity to:

- Make plaster of Paris leaf prints
- Design and make their own flower

Our topic this term is:

- Athletics- they will focus on running, different types of throwing, and jumping

Music:

In music this term the children will be given the opportunity to:

- Learn songs about growing
- Learn songs and chants from around the world
- Look at and try different instruments from around the world
