

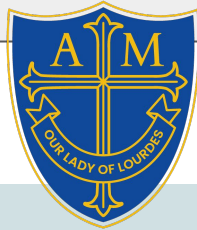
LOL - School Learning

Learning you could try at home (we will put some useful links on Google Classroom):

- Practise your KIRFs and ['Daily 10'](#)
- Practise your doubles and halves
- Practise your tables: 10, 2, 5, 4, 8, 3, 6 and 9 (the more you learn by rote, the better - then you can start applying your knowledge)
- Play board games and be the 'banker'
- Apply your Maths in everyday problems e.g. cooking, shopping, saving up pocket money
- Sing the 'Tricky Words' songs and try and learn those spellings [Phase 3](#), [Phase 4](#)
- Learn about [homophone spellings](#) and [prefixes](#)
- Find out some facts about our bodies (brains, skeleton, eyes, teeth, digestive system, nutrition etc.)
- Read, read, read - anything and everything!

KIRFs (Key Instant Recall Facts)

At OLOL, we have focused in on ensuring that children are learning their number facts (number bonds and times tables).
